Edward Adlesic, DMD

Dr. Edward C. Adlesic received his dental degree in 1980 from the University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine. He then entered the four year oral and maxillofacial surgery residency program at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital in Philadelphia. Upon completion of his residency in 1984, he returned to Pittsburgh to practice Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. He was Chief of Oral and Maxillofacial Services at the Western Pennsylvania Hospital in Pittsburgh for 18 years. In 2015, he retired from private practice and accepted a faculty position at the University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine as an Assistant Professor in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. In 2018, he received a dual appointment in the Department of Dental Anesthesiology. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, a fellow in the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, a fellow in the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology, and a Diplomate of the National Dental Board of Anesthesiology. Dr. Adlesic also serves as a Director for the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology. He is a member of the AAOMS Committee on Anesthesia as well. Dr. Adlesic is a principal in Anesthesia Education in Dentistry, LLC; a company that provides continuing education for anesthesia permit holders in Pennsylvania. He has published articles and book chapters on Anesthesia in the Dental Office, and has lectured extensively at AAOMS and ADSA national and regional meetings.

Patient Safety and Risk Management for the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon

This course aims to provide attendees with the enhanced tools necessary to promote patient safety and improve outcomes while reducing liability and exposure to risks. OMSNIC's team of speakers will utilize a collaborative learning environment to illustrate contemporary day-to-day risks in the OMS practice through a detailed analysis of claim examples. The highlighted topics include nerve injury, communication, infection & failure to diagnose, medication management, documentation, emergency preparedness and informed consent.

- Identify aspects of communication and documentation with potentially challenging implications to the OMS practice
- Implement new strategies to help prevent failure to diagnose allegations and improve management of infection cases
- Establish best practices to help ensure preparation for and management of in-office emergencies
- Describe and manage informed consent challenges
- Recognize the potential effect technology and applied risk management can have on mitigating and managing nerve injury



Colin S. Bell, DDS, MSD

A Dallas area native and Phi Beta Kappa graduate of Southern Methodist University, Colin Bell received his dental degree from Baylor College of Dentistry in 1979, and completed oral and maxillofacial surgery training at Baylor University Medical Center in 1984. As an active member of the American Dental Association and the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons (AAOMS), he currently serves in the AAOMS House of Delegates. He has previously completed terms as the president of both the Texas Society of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons and the Southwest Society of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons. Most recently Dr. Bell served as the chairman of the Oral and Maxillofacial Political Action Committee Board of Directors and was subsequently elected as a director of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. Dr. Bell serves as a clinical professor of oral and maxillofacial surgery at the Baylor College of Dentistry, Texas A&M Health Science Center in Dallas, and holds fellowship status in both the American and International College of Dentists. He is a director of OMSNIC. Dr. Bell maintains an active private practice.
