



The Georgia Board for Physician Workforce administers a state program to assist dentists with the repayment of loans they obtained while attending dental school. The Dentists for Rural Areas Assistance Program provides service-cancellable loans of up to \$25,000 per year in return for full-time dental practice in an underserved, rural county in Georgia (a population of 35,000 or less based on the most recent U.S. Census). Contracts are awarded for one year and are renewable three times for a maximum of four years. Funding for this program is provided by the State of Georgia. <b>Dentists for Rural Areas Assistance Program</b>	
<b>Who can apply?</b>	Applicants must be a legal resident the U.S., have graduated from an accredited graduate dental education program or provisional accreditation by the American Dental Association’s Commission on Dental Accreditation, have an unrestricted dental license by the Georgia Board of Dentistry, hold or be in the process of receiving a Medicaid Provider Number in Georgia and actively treat Medicaid patients
<b>When should I apply?</b>	The application period runs from Sept. 1 through Oct. 31 on the GBPW website
<b>What is the amount of the award?</b>	For 2017, there will be 12 awards of up to \$25,000 each for the Dentists for Rural Areas Assistance Program
<b>What is the renewal process?</b>	Applicants must reapply each year, and if there are no substantial changes over the previous year, the application will be automatically renewed. However, substantial changes will require the application to be ranked as a new application.
<b>What is the service repayment?</b>	One year of working full-time in a Georgia county of 35,000 or less people for each year of funding received
<b>What are the penalties for not completing the obligation?</b>	Double the principal amount received
