Her clinical practice focuses on the comprehensive rehabilitation for facial deformities and tumor resection surgeries including reconstructive surgery, dental implant rehabilitation Her clinical and translational research focuses on oral cancer epidemiology, technological advances in cancer surgery, and mechanisms for oral carcinogenesis.
